Tuesday, October 1: Mount Vernon

Wednesday, October 2: Manassas Battlefield Park

Our tour to the Manassas Battlefield Park departs. Manassas, also known as Bull Run is the site of two major American Civil War battles. The first battle, July 21, 1861, was a Confederate victory that made both sides realize the Civil War was going to last longer than anyone thought.



Our tour continues to the Vint Hill Craft Winery – where our military intercepted the German Encryption codes that started the end of World War II and our own National Security Agency (NSA).



We will enjoy a wine tasting before returning to the hotel about 4:00 pm.

Today is the day we will visit our nation's capital. Our **Washington**, **DC** guided tour will view the White House and US Capitol buildings (outside) before continuing on our Memorial tour.



We will see the World War II Memorial, Thomas Jefferson Memorial, Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, and the Vietnam Women's Memorial before stopping at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial where we will lay a wreath to the fallen. Friday, October 4: National Museum of the **United States Army**
